Definitions & Clarifications

- 1) Nesting Cover: Any project that results in the planting of grasses used for upland bird nesting
- 2) Wetland Restoration: Any project that results in either the restoration of an altered wetland or the creation of a new wetland
- 3) Pollinator Habitat: Any project that results in the planting of a diverse planting that includes multiple species of flowering plants. Can be either flowering shrubs or flowering forbs/legumes
- 4) Volunteer Hours: Total hours is calculated by taking the number of people present on project x the number of hours worked on the project
- 5) Disking/interseeding: This activity should not be conducted on native prairie, only conduct on acres that were previously ag land prior to grass being established
- 6) Other Maintenance: This category includes work done to promote upland wildlife species habitat and populations such as wildlife guzzlers, tree removal, weed control, or any other activities that are conducted to help establishment of cover or prevent the degradation of existing habitat
